



**WEATHER ADVISORY NO. 3 (FINAL)**

**FOR: LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) AND TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT**  
**ISSUED AT: 11:00 AM, 08 MARCH 2020**

**AT 10:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 180 KM SOUTH SOUTHEAST OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN (8.2°N, 119.2°E). THIS LPA IS NOT EXPECTED TO DEVELOP INTO TROPICAL DEPRESSION AND MAY DISSIPATE WITHIN 24 TO 48 HOURS. HOWEVER, THIS WEATHER DISTURBANCE WILL BRING LIGHT TO MODERATE WITH ISOLATED HEAVY RAINS DURING THUNDERSTORMS OVER PALAWAN. THE NEXT UPDATE ON THIS LPA WILL BE INCORPORATED IN THE 4:00 PM PUBLIC WEATHER FORECAST TODAY. MEANWHILE, THE TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT HAS RECEDED AND IS NO LONGER AFFECTING THE COUNTRY.**
