



## SEVERE WEATHER BULLETIN #3-FINAL

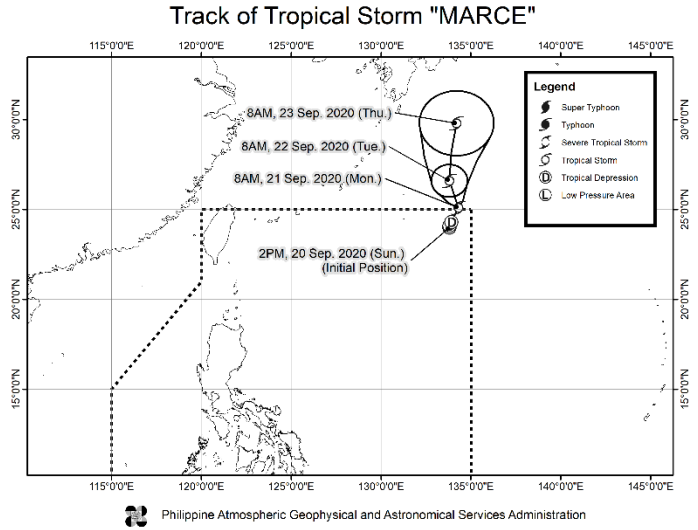
### FOR: TROPICAL STORM "MARCE" TROPICAL CYCLONE: ALERT

ISSUED AT 11:00 AM, 21 September 2020

**"MARCE" INTENSIFIES INTO A TROPICAL STORM AND IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).**

- **This tropical cyclone is not expected to affect any land area or coastal waters of the country.**
- Track and intensity outlook:**
- "MARCE" exited the PAR at 6:00 AM today. On the forecast track, "MARCE" will move generally northward or north-northwestward today and will turn north-northeastward tomorrow.
  - "MARCE" was upgraded to tropical storm category at 8:00 AM today. This tropical cyclone will continuously intensify throughout the forecast period. It is forecast to transition into an extratropical low on Thursday.
- Other disturbance being monitored:**
- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of San Jose, Northern Samar (12.5°N, 124.5°E). This LPA is forecast to dissipate within 24 hours.


<b>Location of eye/center</b>	At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at <b>1,400 km East Northeast of Extreme Northern Luzon (OUTSIDE PAR) (25.2°N, 134.6°E).</b>
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum sustained winds of <b>75 km/h</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>90 km/h.</b>
<b>Movement</b>	Moving <b>North Northeastward</b> at <b>15 km/h.</b>
