

Training Workshop for Typhoon Committee Community Weather Station Project (iCoWIN) 2017

Dates and Venue: 1-3 November 2017, Hong Kong Observatory, Hong Kong, China

Main Theme: Setting up of community weather stations for raising public awareness on climate change and extreme weather

To facilitate more interaction and discussion during the seminar:

- (a) Participant should be familiarized with and has expertise in instrument set up, data communication and dissemination.
- (b) One of the participants from each Member will be invited to represent his/her weather services to deliver a 5-10 minutes presentation regarding weather stations and observations strategy of his/her Service; and
- (c) Each participant will be required to submit a short summary (1 page) on the learning and take-away from the seminar.
- (d) Participating Members will be required to provide regular progress update on the setting up of the iCo-WIN station after the training

- a. to enhance Typhoon Committee Members' capacities in setting up community weather stations for raising public awareness on weather and climate change
- b. to promote contribution and sharing of community weather observations to iCowin project (<http://www.icowin.org/>)
- c. to promote the use of new communication technology and strategies to facilitate sharing of weather information among the community
