



GENERAL FLOOD ADVISORY #5 (Final)
For Region 10 (Northern Mindanao)
Issued at 7:00 pm, 17 November 2017

PRESENT WEATHER :

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "TINO" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 75 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN (9.6N, 119.4E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAIN WINDS OF UP TO 55 KM/H AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 28 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL :

LIGHT RAINS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED :

- **LANAO DEL NORTE** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY MANDULOG, AGUS, LIANGAN AND MARANDING.
- **MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY CLARIN, PALILAN AND ALORAN.
- **MISAMIS ORIENTAL** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY ODIONGAN, GINGOOG, BALATOCAN, CABULIG, LOWER TAGALUAN, LOWER/MIDDLE WESTERN CAGAYAN, IPONON AND ALUBIJID.
- **BUKIDNON** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY UPPER TAGALUAN AND UPPER/EASTERN CAGAYAN.

WITH THIS DEVELOPMENT AND UNLESS SIGNIFICANT RAIN OCCURS, THIS IS THE FINAL GENERAL FLOOD ADVISORY FOR THIS EVENT.
