PRESENT WEATHER :

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "TINO" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 305 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN (10.6N, 116.1E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF UP TO 55 KM/H AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 28 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL :

LIGHT TO OCCASIONALLY MODERATE RAINS

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED :

- **AGUSAN DEL SUR** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY OJOT, WAWA, LIBANG, MAOSAM, KASILAN, GIBONG, ADGAOAN, SINULAO, KAYONAN AND ANDANAN.
- **AGUSAN DEL NORTE** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LAKE-MAINIT-TUBAY, ASIGA, AGUSAN, LINUGOS AND CABADBARAN.
- **DINAGAT ISLANDS** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY MALINAO INLET AND GAAS LULET.
- **SURIGAO DEL NORTE** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY SURIGAO AND MAGALLANES.
- **SURIGAO DEL SUR** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY CANTILLAN, TORACAN, TANDAG, TAGO, HUBO-OTEIZA, HINATUAN AND BISLIG.
