PRESENT WEATHER :

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "TINO" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 305 KM WEST NORTHWEST OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN (10.6N, 116.1E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF UP TO 55 KM/H AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 28 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL :

LIGHT TO OCCASIONALLY MODERATE RAINS AND THUNDERSTORMS

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED :

- **CAMARINES NORTE** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LABO AND DAET BASUD.
- **CATANDUANES** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY CABUYAN, BATO AND PAJO.
- **MASBATE** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LANANG, MAPAYAWAN, MANDAONG, ASID, MALBAG, GUIOM, NAINDAY, DARAGA, NAUCO (AGUADA) AND BELENO.
- **ALBAY** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY GUINALE AND UPPER DONSOL.
- **SORSOGON** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LOWER DONSOL, OGDOD, PUTIAO, CADACAN, BANUANG-DUAN, FABRICA (TUGBUGAN) AND MATNOG.
- **CAMARINES SUR** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LOWER KILBAY CATABANGAN, RAGAY, TINALMUD, TAMBANG AND LAGONOY.

PEOPLE LIVING NEAR THE MOUNTAINS SLOPES AND IN THE LOW LYING AREAS OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED RIVER SYSTEMS AND THE **LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS** CONCERNED ARE STILL ADVISED TO TAKE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES.
