PRESENT WEATHER:

At 10:00 PM yesterday, the center of Tropical Storm "BASYANG" was estimated based on all available data at 300 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.5 °N, 128.9°E). Northern Mindanao will experience stormy weather due to TS Basyang.

BASIN-AVERAGED RAINFALL:

PAST 24-HR RAINFALL: 15.71 mm

FORECAST RAINFALL:

SCATTERED TO WIDESPREAD MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS.


WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:
