Regional Summary

During the month, harvesting and pre-planting activities were ongoing in the region. This suggests that the minimal rainfall of the region for the month may not cause a negative effect on harvesting activities in the area. However, such rainfall may hinder planting activities without the intervention of an irrigation system.

Despite the minimal rainfall, the Standardized Precipitation-Evapotranspiration Index for the last three months (SPEI3) signifies that the region had enough moisture, making any potential water stress manageable.

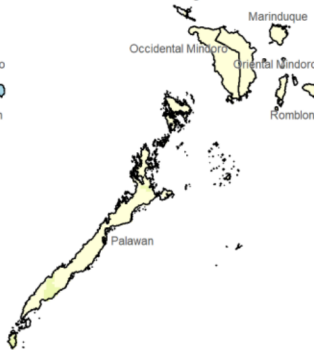
