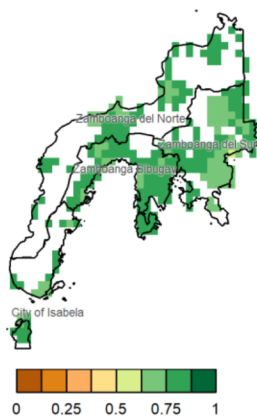

## Regional Summary

There was generally no activity for rice and corn crops in the Region during the month. However, excessive rainfall for the month possibly caused harm to any standing corn crops in the Region as well as for the rice crops at any stage in Isabela City. The rainfall for the month was generally sufficient for rice crops at any stage for the rest of the region.

The NDVI indicates crops at generally good condition for the month. The SPEI3 shows slightly wetter than normal conditions experienced in the entire region for the past three months. Furthermore, significant extreme rainfall might have caused impact in any standing rice and corn crops in the Province of Isabela, and southern portion of Zamboanga Sibugay and Zamboanga del Norte. This could be associated to the rainfall from the shear line, Low Pressure Area (LPA), and localized thunderstorms experienced in the third week of the month.
