OVERVIEW

- Warm El Niño Southern Oscillation (ENSO)-neutral condition has persisted in the tropical Pacific during July-August-September 2018 season.
- Majority of climate models predict a probability of El Niño to develop during October-November-December 2018 season.

Assessment in September 2018

WEATHER SYSTEMS THAT AFFECTED THE COUNTRY

LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)

Areas of lowest pressure characterized by cloudiness and rainshowers; areas where a tropical cyclone can form



SOUTHWEST MONSOON (HABAGAT) (((H RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE

Warm moist winds from the southwest causing rains over the western portion of the country from May to September



An extension of a high pressure area characterized by very light wind and clear skies



Isolated heavy and dense dark clouds with one or more sudden electric discharges manifested by lightning and thunder often accompanied by showers



4 TROPICAL CYCLONES

Typhoon (TY) "Maymay" (September 2) Tropical Depression (TD) "Neneng" (September 10) Typhoon (TY) "Ompong" (September 12-15) Typhoon (TY) "Paeng" (September 23-29)



INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ)

Series of low pressure areas brought about by converging northeast (NE) and southeast (SE) winds that cause thunderstorms and rainshowers

RAINFALL CONDITION



ABOVE NORMAL

120% greater than the normal



NEAR NORMAL

+20% or -20% from the normal

Most parts of the country including Metro Manila



BELOW NORMAL

20%-60% reduction from the normal

Ilocos Norte, Batangas, Quezon, most provinces in MIMAROPA, Camarines Norte, Northern Panay, Leyte, Davao City, Davao del Sur and Cotabato received below normal rainfall.



TEMPERATURE

Mountainous Luzon $15.8^{\circ}C - 23.3^{\circ}C$

Lowlands Luzon $21.7^{\circ}C - 33.2^{\circ}C$

Metro Manila $25.6^{\circ}C - 31.6^{\circ}C$

Visayas $24.2^{\circ}C - 32.7^{\circ}C$

Mountainous Mindanao $20.0^{\circ}C - 29.1^{\circ}C$

Lowlands Mindanao $22.1^{\circ}C - 33.4^{\circ}C$







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Outlook in October 2018

EXPECTED WEATHER SYSTEMS



Isolated heavy and dense dark clouds with one or more sudden electric discharges manifested by lightning and thunder often accompanied by showers of rain.

(((H RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE AREA (HPA)

An extension of a high pressure area characterized by very light wind and clear skies



INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ)

Series of low pressure areas brought about by converging northeast (NE) and southeast (SE) winds that cause thunderstorms and rainshowers

LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)

Areas of lowest pressure characterized by cloudiness and rainshowers; areas where a tropical cyclone can form



2 or 3 Tropical cyclone

"Bagyo"; may refer to tropical depression, tropical storm, severe tropical storm, typhoon, or super typhoon.

RAINFALL CONDITION



+20% or -20% from the normal

Most parts of Visayas and Mindanao



20%-60% reduction from the normal

Most parts of Luzon



TEMPERATURE

Mountainous Luzon
13°C – 27°C

Lowlands Luzon 19°C – 36°C Metro Manila 21°C – 35°C

Visayas 22°C – 36°C Mountainous Mindanao 16° C – 33° C

Lowlands Mindanao 21°C – 36°C
