Enhanced Southwest Monsoon is forecasted to prevail in most parts of Western Luzon and some areas in Western Visayas.





Increase of rainfall of 40-100mm is expected in most parts of Central Luzon and Ilocos Norte while rainfall deficit of more than 100mm in Mt. Province, Ifugao and most parts of Visayas and northern Mindanao; 20-80mm for the rest of Luzon and Mindanao.




High to a very high probability to exceed 25mm in most parts of Northern and Central Luzon, Cavite, Rizal and Occidental Mindoro; moderate to high chance over Batangas and Laguna while low to moderate chance over the rest of the country.




High to a very high probability to exceed 50mm of rainfall in most parts of Ilocos region, CAR and Central Luzon; moderate to high likelihood over Cavite, Rizal and Occidental Mindoro while low chance over the rest of the country.






Moderate to high probability to exceed 200mm of rainfall over the western section of Ilocos Region, Bataan and Zambales while low chance wong over the rest of the country.









GEFS Week-1 & 2 Forecasts: T2m Anomaly



2m Temperature Week 1: July 31 - Aug 06, 2023

Slightly warmer to warmer than average surface air temperature will likely experience in most parts eastern Visayas and Mindanao while average to slightly cooler temperature is expected for the rest of the





2m Temperature Week 2: Aug 07-13, 2023

Average to cooler than average surface air temperature will likely experience in most parts of the country except in most areas of ASA eastern Luzon & Mindanao , Sultan Kudarat and Maguindanao where slightly warmer temperature is expected.
