







Week 1: Nov 20-26, 2023




Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Easterlies affecting the rest of the country.







# **Precipitation Anomaly and Exceedance Probability > 25/50 mm**



# Week 1: Nov 20-26, 2023




Rainfall deficit of 10-60mm is expected in most parts of the country except in Aurora, Quezon, Bicol Region, Aklan and Capiz where 40-90mm increase of rainfall is more likely.



### Probability to Exceed 25mm

- High to very high over most parts of the country;
- Moderate to high over Ilocos Region and the western part of central Luzon.



### **Probability to Exceed 50mm**

- High to very high over Bicol Region and Samar provinces;
- Moderate to high over the eastern part of Luzon, Western Visayas, Palawan, Northern Mindanao and Zamboanga Peninsula;
- Low to moderate over the rest of the country.










### **Probability to Exceed 100mm**

- · Low elsewhere.



### Probability to Exceed 200mm




# Precipitation Anomaly and Exceedance Probability > 25/50 mm



# Week 2: Nov 27- Dec 03, 2023




Rainfall deficit of 10-60mm is expected in most parts of the country except in eastern part of Isabela and Aurora where 20-40mm increase of rainfall is more likely.



### **Probability to Exceed 25mm**

- High to very high over most parts of CAR, Eastern Luzon, Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas and most of Mindanao
- Moderate to high over the rest of the country.




## Probability to Exceed 50mm


- Moderate to high over Eastern Luzon, Bicol Region, Oriental Mindoro, Palawan, Eastern Visayas, Aklan, Capiz, and most of Mindanao;
- Low to moderate elsewhere.


### Probability to Exceed 100mm

• Low over the rest of the country.









# **Probability to Exceed 150mm**


# **Probability to Exceed 200mm**


# **GEFS Week-1 & 2 Forecasts: T2m Anomaly**



# 2m Temperature Week 1: Nov 20-26, 2023

Average to cooler than average surface air temperature will likely be experienced in most parts of Luzon and Visayas while Mindanao will likely have average to warmer temperature.





# 2m Temperature Week 2: Nov 27- Dec 03, 2023

Average to cooler than average surface air temperature will likely be experienced in most parts of the country except in most parts of Eastern Luzon, Maguindanao and Sultan Kudarat where slightly warmer to warmer than average temperature is expected.
