AWARENESS INFORMATION / ADVISORY		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• LIGHT TO OCCASSIONALLY MODERATE RAINS AND THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITIES ARE FORECAST TO OCCUR OVER THE BUAYAN – MALUNGON RIVER BASIN, AS ANTICIPATED EFFECTS OF INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ) IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS.• BASIN MAJOR HAZARDS SUCH AS FLASH FLOODS, RAIN – INDUCED LANDSLIDES AND URBAN FLOODING REMAIN LESS LIKELY, EXCEPT THE CIRCUMSTANCES DURING / AFTER THE REOCCURRENCE OF MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS AS A RESULT OF SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS.• MINIMAL TO MINOR COASTAL FLOODING WILL LIKELY AFFECT IN COASTAL AREAS OF GENERAL SANTOS CITY AND ALABEL, INCLUDING POSSIBLY THE ADJACENT TOWNS ALONG SARANGANI BAY, DUE TO HIGH TIDE BY EARLY MORNING AND AFTERNOON TIME IN THE NEXT COMING DAYS.• THE PUBLIC AND THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS (LDRRMCs) WITHIN THE BASIN ARE STILL ADVISED TO REMAIN VIGILANT AND ALWAYS MAINTAIN THEIR PREPAREDNESS AND MITIGATING ACTIVITIES FOR POSSIBLE HAZARDS MENTIONED ABOVE THAT MAY POSSIBLY OCCUR WITHIN THEIR AREA OF CONCERN. AND TO CONTINUE MONITORING FOR ALL ISSUED PRODUCTS AND SERVICES INCLUDED IN RAINFALL WATCH SYSTEM FROM MINDANAO PAGASA REGIONAL SERVICES DIVISION (MPRSD); AND OTHER RELEVANT DAILY WEATHER – RELATED INFORMATION ISSUED FROM NATIONAL LEVEL OF DOST – PAGASA.• WITH THIS EVENT AND UNLESS SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS OF WEATHER CONDITION WITHIN THE BASIN OCCURS, THIS IS THE FINAL FLOOD ADVISORY FOR BUAYAN - MALUNGON RIVER BASIN.
