**Declaring Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB); and,
 Recommending Award of Contract and Approval**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), through the PAGASA Bids and Awards Committee, advertised the Invitation to Bid (IB) at the PAGASA website, the MGEPS and PAGASA Bulletin board continuously for 7 days from **7 to 14 December 2022**, the procurement of the following goods/items described hereunder, with its corresponding Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), under the reference, **P.R. No. 2022-10-0819 EPA and 2022-11-0925 EPA / I.B. No. 2022-041**, to wit:

WHEREAS, in response to the above advertisement, **only one (1)** prospective bidder/s, **State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.** expressed its intention to participate in the said bidding activity and attended the **Pre-bid conference on 15 December 2022** scheduled for this purpose;

WHEREAS, any and all noted amendments and deviations discussed during the above-mentioned Pre-bid conference, has been duly issued through a **Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB)**, with reference to **Addendum No. 2022-030-41** dated 19 December 2022 are herein made part of this Resolution as **Annex "A"**;

WHEREAS, on **27 December 2022**, the schedule for **Submission, Receipt and Opening** of Envelope I (Eligibility and Technical Components) and Envelope II (Financial Component), **only State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.** timely submitted its tender documents for the project and passed the preliminary examination of bids;

WHEREAS, in the subsequent opening of Envelope No. II, the lone bidder's financial proposal has been accepted for not exceeding the ABC. Its bid tender, "as Read", is as follows:
