



**PAGASA BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (PBAC)**

**Resolution No. 2023-092**

**Declaring Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB); and,  
 Recommending Award of Contract and Approval**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), through the PAGASA Bids and Awards Committee, advertised the Invitation to Bid (IB) at the PAGASA website, the MGEPS and PAGASA Bulletin board continuously for 7 days from **21 to 28 November 2023**, the procurement of the following goods/items described hereunder, with its corresponding Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), under the reference, **P.R. No. 2023-10-0625 EPA / I.B. No. 2023-023** to wit:

**WHEREAS**, in response to the above advertisement, **only one (1) prospective bidder, State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.** expressed its intention to participate in the bidding of the aforesaid Project and attended the scheduled **Pre-bid conference** conducted by the PBAC on **30 November 2023**;

**WHEREAS**, on **18 December 2023**, the schedule for **Submission, Receipt and Opening** of Envelope I (Eligibility and Technical Components) and Envelope II (Financial Component), **only State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.**, timely submitted its bid tender for the project and passed the preliminary examination of bids;

**WHEREAS**, in the subsequent opening of Envelope No. II, the lone bidder's financial proposal has been accepted for not exceeding the ABC. Its financial proposal, as "Read", is as follows:

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of lone bidder's documents, including the evaluation report submitted by the TWG, the PAGASA-BAC determined that **State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.** has complied accordingly on all the criteria for post-qualification and was responsive to all requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents. Hence, it was moved and duly seconded that **State Alliance Enterprises, Inc.** be declared as the **Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder (SCRB)** for the Project.

**WHEREAS**, with reference to the above-mentioned TWG Report, the BAC noted that, **Php11,795,000.00** out of the total amount of the lone bidder's bid proposal as "calculated" was proposed for the quarterly preventive and corrective maintenance of the Hinatuan Weather Radar Transmitter and Receiver Units. Considering the recent development wherein the said station was declared structurally unsafe by the DPWH after it incurred damage caused by the magnitude 7.4 earthquake that struck the area last 02 December 2023; and, notwithstanding the re-calculation, the PAGASA-BAC, acknowledging the lone bidder's expertise, resources and capability in installing and maintenance of weather radar systems, unanimously concurred to propose the utilization of the said amount for the possible dismantling, salvaging and demolition of the radar equipment and building. *Provided, however*, that if the lone bidder concurs with the proposition, the latter shall submit a separate price quotation for the said purpose. *Provided, further*, that should the price quotation submitted be lower than the amount intended thereto, the price variance shall be reverted to PAGASA and deducted to the total contract cost of the Project. *Provided, finally*, that any negotiations and/or agreements other than the original purpose of the instant Project must be reduced in writing and in accordance with the pertinent guidelines and procedures provided under the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;
