



PAGASA Bids and Awards Committee Resolution (BAC)

Resolution No. 2024-043

Resolution Declaring Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder (SCRB); and Recommending Award of Contract and Approval

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA), through the PAGASA Bids and Awards Committee, advertised the Invitation to Bid (IB) at the PAGASA website, the MGEPS and PAGASA Bulletin board continuously for 7 days from **23 to 30 July 2024**, the procurement of the following civil works/infrastructure project described hereunder, with its corresponding Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), under the reference, **P.R. No. 2024-05-0390 / I.B. No. 2024-026 INF** to wit:

WHEREAS, in response to the above advertisement, **no prospective bidder/s**, expressed its intention to participate in the bidding of the aforesaid Project, on the scheduled **Pre-bid conference** conducted by the PBAC on **01 August 2024**;

WHEREAS, on **13 August 2024**, the schedule for **Submission, Receipt and Opening** of Envelope No.1 (Eligibility and Technical Components) and Envelope No. II (Financial Component); **two (2) participating bidder/s**, (1) **ARV Construction and Supply** and (2) **Rock 101 Construction and Supply**, timely submitted their bid tender documents for the project; however, ARV Construction and Supply failed to pass the preliminary evaluation of bids due to non-submission of *Tab I – Joint Venture Agreement Form*;

WHEREAS, applying the non-discretionary **“pass/fail”** criterion in the evaluation of bids the PAGASA BAC declared the outright rejection of ARV Construction and Supply's documents based on the foregoing findings and were given three (3) calendar days to file their request for reconsideration should they desire to do so;

WHEREAS, in the subsequent opening of Envelope No. II, the bidder's financial proposal has been accepted by the PAGASA-BAC having complied with the financial requirements of the Projects; The financial proposal, **“as Read”**, is summarized as follows:

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of the bidder's tender documents, including the evaluation report submitted by the TWG, the PAGASA-BAC determined that, **Rock 101 Construction and Supply** has complied accordingly on all the criteria for post-qualification and was responsive on all requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents, Hence, it was moved and duly seconded that the **Rock 101 Construction and Supply** be declared as the **Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder (SCRB)** for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a) to **DECLARE**, **Rock 101 Construction and Supply** as the Bidder with the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) for the Project entitled, "*Construction of PAGASA-DMMMSU Synoptic Station Building, Observer's Quarters, Powerhouse, Perimeter Fence, Gate and Signage*;
- b) to **RECOMMEND**, that award of the Contract to **Rock 101 Construction and Supply**, in the total calculated amount of *Seven Million Nineteen Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen Pesos & 47/100 (Php7,019,216.47)* only, for the implementation of Project; and
- c) to **RECOMMEND**, finally, the **APPROVAL** of the foregoing findings and recommendations.
