WITHIN THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS FROM DATE OF QUOTATION

- **AWARDEE** shall be responsible for the source(s) of his supplies/materials/equipment shall make deliveries in accordance with schedule, quality and specifications of the award and purchase order. Failure by the **AWARDEE** to comply with the same shall be ground for cancellation of the award and purchase order issued to that AWARDEE and for re-awarding the item(s) to the **ALTERNATE AWARDEE**.
 - **AWARDEE** shall pick up purchase order(s) issued in his favor within three (3) days after receipt of notice to that effect. A telephone call or fax transmission shall constitute an official notice to the **AWARDEE**. Thereafter, if the purchase order(s) **remain unclaimed**, the said purchase order(s) shall be sent by messengerial service to the **AWARDEE** at the latter's expense. To avoid delay in the delivery of the requesting agency's, all **DEFAULTING AWARDEES** shall be precluded from proposing or submitting a substitute sample.
 - Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, where **AWARDEE** has accepted a purchase order but fails to deliver the required product(s) within the time called for in the same order, he shall be extended a maximum of fifteen (15) calendar days under liquidated damages to make good his deliveries. Thereafter if **AWARDEE** has not completed delivery within the extended period, the subject purchase order shall be cancelled and the award for the undelivered balance withdrawn from the **AWARDEE**. The Procurement Service shall then purchase the required item(s) from such other source(s) as it may determine, with the difference in price to be charged against the **DEFAULTING AWARDEE**. Refusal by the **DEFAULTING AWARDEE** to shoulder the price difference shall be ground for his disqualitfication from future bids on the same or all items, without prejudice to the imposition of other sanctions as prescribed under RA 9184 and its IRR.
 - All deliveries by suppliers shall be subject to inspection and acceptance by the <u>PAGASA Committee</u>, All necessary laboratory test undertaken by the <u>PAGASA</u> shall be for the account of the supplier.
- Rejected deliveries shall be construed as non-delivery of product(s)/item(s) so ordered and shall be subject to liquidated damages, subject to the terms and conditions prescribed under paragraph 4 hereof.
- Supplier shall guarantee his deliveries to be free from defects. Any defective item(s) / product(s), therefore that may be discovered by the <u>PAGASA</u> within three (3) months after acceptance of the same, shall be replaced by the supplier with seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of a written notice to that effect.
- A penalty of one-tenth of one percent (0.001) of the total value of the prodcut(s)/good(s) purchase shall be deducted for each day of delay in the delivery of the product(s)/good(s) ordered.
- All duties, excise and other taxes and revenue charges, if any, shall be for the supplier's account.
- As pre-condition to payment, IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS specifically showing the condition and serial numbers of imported equipment purchased should be submitted by the supplier to the <u>PAGASA</u>
- All transactions are subject to withholding of credible Value Added Tax (VAT) per Republic Act 10963 or Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion or the TRAIN Law
