As stated in the <b>Checklist of Requirements:</b>  Bidders that have previously submitted their Bid Documents may opt to submit Envelope No. 2 - Financial Component <b>only</b> . However, please be reminded that <b>Tabs E, F, and G remain mandatory for submission</b> . The previously submitted Envelope No. 1 will be considered by the BAC. <b>For new bidders</b> , it is required to <b>submit both</b> Envelope No. 1 and 2 in its entirety.  To facilitate the review of Technical documents of new bidders, online submission of Envelope No. 1 is allowed no later than <b>December 17, Tuesday</b> .

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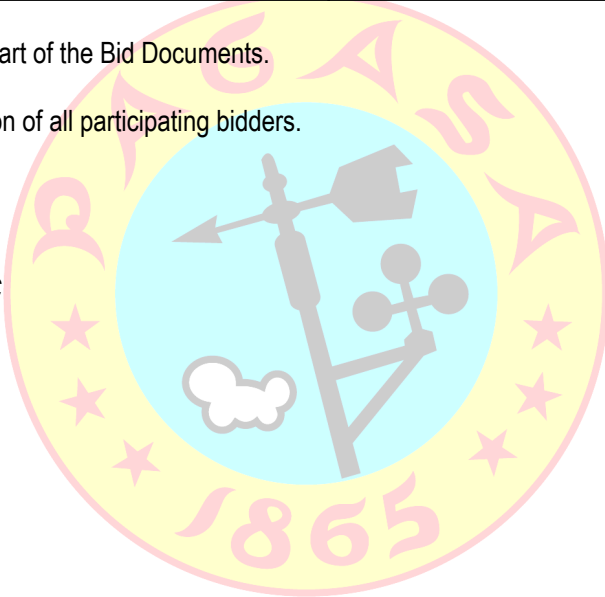

1. I/We understand that, according to your conditions, bids must be supported by a Bid Security, which may be in the form of a Bid-Securing Declaration.

I/We accept that: (a) I/we will be automatically disqualified from bidding for any contract with any procuring entity for a period of two (2) years upon receipt of your Blacklisting Order; and, (b) I/we will pay the applicable fine provided under Section 6 of the Guidelines on the Use of Bid Securing Declaration<sup>3</sup>, if I/we have committed any of the following actions:
  - (i) Withdrawn my/our Bid during the period of bid validity required in the Bidding Documents; or
  - (ii) Fail or refuse to accept the award and enter into contract or perform any and all acts necessary to the execution of the Contract, in accordance with the Bidding Documents after having been notified of your acceptance of our Bid during the period of bid validity.
  - (iii) Commit/s any act/s resulting to the forfeiture of bid security under Sections 23.1(b), 34.2, 40.1 and 69.1, except 69.1(f), of the IRR of RA 9184 and/or any other applicable provision/s of RA 9184 and/or its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
3. I/We understand that this Bid-Securing Declaration shall cease to be valid on the following circumstances:
  - (a) Upon expiration of the bid validity period, or any extension thereof pursuant to your request;
  - (b) I am/we are declared ineligible or post-disqualified upon receipt of your notice to such effect, and (i) I/we failed to timely file a request for reconsideration or (ii) I/we filed a waiver to avail of said right;
  - (c) I am/we are declared as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid/Highest Rated and Responsive Bid<sup>4</sup>, and I/we have furnished the performance security and signed the Contract.
4. In accordance with Section 3(b) above, I/We/It agree/s to pay you a fine, within fifteen (15) days from receipt of written demand and without prejudice to other legal action/s you may undertake, as follows:

i) In case of multiple bidders:

Two Percent (2%) of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) or the Difference between the evaluated bid prices of the bidder with the Lowest Calculated/Highest Rated Bid and the bidder with the next Lowest Calculated/Highest Rated Bid, and so on, whichever is HIGHER;

As regards the bidder with the Highest Calculated/Lowest Rated Bid, the amount shall be Two Percent (2%) of the ABC or the Difference between the evaluated bid price and the ABC, whichever is HIGHER;

ii) In case of a single bidder:

Two Percent (2%) of the ABC or the Difference between the evaluated bid price and the Approved Budget for the Contract, whichever is HIGHER.

iii) Violations committed prior to opening of financial envelope:

A fixed amount equivalent to two percent (2%) of the ABC.
