

All other bidding documents issued by the BAC to prospective bidders remain the same.</p>

Projects involving GSM/3G/4G modems or satellite uplinks for continuous data reporting.</i></p>	<p>ITB Clause 5.3 (a) is mandatory and cannot be subjected to any amendment or revision. Thus, it shall be maintained accordingly.</p>
