<p>Request to change the following:</p> <p>From:</p> <p>Power Rear View Mirror (adjust & retract) Spare Tire (215/70 R16C steel w/ Full cap</p> <p>To:</p> <p>Manual Adjust 195/70 R15 Steel rim w/ center cover</p>	<p>This is to accept the requested change from Power Rear View Mirror (Adjust + Retract) to Manual Adjustable Rear View Mirror, provided that the unit to be offered shall include a two-way rear camera system, to ensure that rear visibility remains clear, continuous, and safe during both forward maneuvering and reverse operation.</p> <p>On the tire size requirement (215/70R16C), we are maintaining the existing technical specification as it has been assessed to be reasonable, relevant, and necessary to achieve the required operational performance, particularly for long-distance travel, heavy payload transport, and varied terrain deployment based on the intended project use. This specification ensures higher load-bearing capacity, improved ground clearance, better traction, and enhanced long-term durability, which ultimately supports lower life-cycle and maintenance costs and contributes to safe and reliable project operations.</p> <p>Thus, it shall read:</p> <p>From: Power Rear View Mirror (adjust & retract) Spare Tire (215/70 R16C steel w/ Full cap</p> <p>To Rear View mirror/camera with two-way camera Spare Tire (215/70 R16C steel w/ Full cap</p>

<p>Features: Item no. 3 Power Rear View Mirror (adjust + retract)</p> <p>Request to change to:</p> <p>Rear View mirror/camera with two-way camera (upgrade)</p> <p>The reason for revising the current technical specification, “<i>Power Rear View Mirror</i>” is that such a feature does not exist in any brand of motor vehicle. Upon verification, the only commonly available power features are Power Windows and Power Door Locks.</p>	<p>This is to acknowledge and accept the proposed changes of providing a rear-view mirror/camera system with two-way view capability, as this can enhance driver awareness, safety visibility, and maneuvering precision both during reverse and forward driving. The proposal may be considered provided that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The upgraded feature must ensure continuous visibility of the rear area during both forward and reverse movement, even in narrow, congested, off-road and low-light conditions. 2. The system must be factory-installed or OEM-approved to maintain vehicle integrity, warranty, and electrical safety. 3. The upgrade must not eliminate or reduce visibility via standard mirrors, but must complement operational visibility requirements for field deployment. 4. The final offered configuration must remain within the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) and delivered without post-delivery modification or additional upgrade costs.

<p>Bid Data Sheet; Page 44; Clause 16.1</p> <p>May I clarify that if we opt to submit a BID SECURING DECLARATION using the prescribed form on Page 86, would it be acceptable? Upon preparing our Bid, I was confused to see on Page 89 of the Bidding Documents, CHECKLIST OF TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS, FOR TAB G, it is indicated that NGPA Bid Securing Declaration is NOT APPLICABLE. Kindly clarify because on the Bid Data Sheet, Bid Securing Declaration is acceptable, however on Page 89, it says NOT APPLICABLE</p>	<p>Please note that the notation “Not Applicable” on Page 89 refers only to the column indicating the amount required for the Bid Security. Since a Bid Securing Declaration (BSD) does not require a monetary amount, the field is marked accordingly.</p> <p>For clarification, the Bid Securing Declaration remains an acceptable form of Bid Security, as provided under Bid Data Sheet, Clause 16.1. Therefore, bidders may submit the Bid Securing Declaration using the prescribed form on Page 86 of the Bidding Documents.</p>
<p>Spare Tire (215/70R16C steel rim with full wheel cap)</p>	<p>The tire and rim size required applies to both the installed and spare tires. The official required</p>

<p>It is indicated that this requirement is for SPARE TIRE only.</p> <p>For the purpose of clarity and to avoid possible modifications, may I please request to indicate the required TIRES AND RIMS size for the entire unit (not only spare tire): TIRES AND RIMS SIZE: 215/70R16C steel rim with full wheel cap as specified on the unamended brochure.</p> <p>There was one bidder from other brand, in a bidding that I recently joined (also for PASSENGER VANS) who wrote "COMPLY" on the Statement of Compliance for Technical Specifications even the tires and rim description does not match with the brochure of the Passenger Van that they are offering. Later during the evaluation, it was revealed that their plan is to modify the tires, which lead to disqualification.</p>	<p>specification is:</p> <p>215/70R16C steel rims with full wheel cap for all tires.</p>
