<p><b>SLCC</b></p> <p>For SLCC, could we use Supply and Delivery of Laptop?</p>	<p>In accordance with Section 52.4.1.3 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A.12009 for the procurement of goods, a bidder is required to submit a Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the project, with a value of at least fifty percent (50%) of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC).</p> <p>For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to any contract that involves:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Supply, Delivery, Testing and Commissioning of High-Performance Workstation</li> <li>b. Supply, Delivery, Testing and Commissioning of various ICT Equipment</li> <li>c. Completed within 3 years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Technical Specification</b>  <b>Storage: 2TB SSD TLC with DRAM M.2 2280 PCIe Gen4 SED Ready</b></p> <p>Is "2 TB, M.2 2280, TLC PCIe Gen4, SSD, SED Ready" acceptable for the storage as it has the same function with the "Storage 2 TB SSD TLC with DRAM M.2 2280 PCIe Gen4 SED Ready"?</p>	<p>Yes, this is acceptable as long as the offered unit has equivalent specifications and functionality.</p>

<b>Technical Specification: Chassis</b>  Requested that the specification for the Chassis be relaxed to the manufacturer's default.	The chassis identified in the Terms of Reference is a slim-form unit. Modifying the chassis specification may result in changes to the workstation's required dimensions and associated component layout.

**Queries from: Idenico Computer Corporation**

Particulars / Concerns	Amendments / Clarifications
<b>Technical Specification: Processor</b>  Sought clarification if they can offer AMD for the processor.	We should follow the specifications indicated in the Terms of Reference because switching to an AMD processor would likewise require replacing the workstation's main motherboard.
