<p><b>E.1 Access Point (105 units)</b> <b>Performance Capacity. Up to 10 SSID</b></p> <p>Based on the project scope, only two (2) SSIDs (e.g., Guest and Employee) are intended to be utilized.</p> <p>In this regard, we respectfully request consideration to relax the SSID requirement from ten (10) to at least eight (8), as this will sufficiently meet the operational needs without affecting system performance or functionality</p>	<p>We require at least ten (10) SSIDs for our future setup to ensure sufficient network segmentation and flexibility to support current and anticipated operational requirements.</p>
<p><b>E.1 Access Point (105 units)</b> <b>Security, Wireless Intrusion and Prevention System (WIPS) and Wireless Intrusion Detection System(WIDS).</b></p> <p>We respectfully request reconsideration of this specification. We propose either removing the WIPS requirement or allowing compliance with either WIPS or WIDS.</p>	<p>We require this capability to enhance the security posture of our wireless network by enabling effective monitoring, detection, and prevention of unauthorized access and potential wireless threats.</p>
<p><b>E.1 Access Point (105 units)</b> <b>Management, QoS-based scheduling</b></p> <p>With regard to “QoS-based scheduling,” we respectfully request clarification on the specific functionality or parameters being required</p>	<p>We require this functionality to ensure interoperability in managing network traffic across various applications and devices.</p>
<p><b>E.1 Access Point (105 units)</b> <b>Accessories, With latching mechanism</b></p> <p>With regard to “latching mechanism,” we respectfully request clarification on the specific functionality or parameters being required</p>	<p>A latching mechanism is used to securely hold the access point for ceiling mounting, ensuring stable installation, proper alignment, and preventing accidental detachment or movement once installed.</p>
<p><b>E.2 AP Controller (2 units)</b> <b>Features, MIMO and PSK and QR Code authentication</b></p> <p>We respectfully request reconsideration of the MIMO requirement. We propose allowing compliance with MIMO or equivalent technologies that deliver comparable wireless performance, capacity, and reliability</p> <p>We also respectfully request reconsideration of the requirement for both PSK and QR Code authentication. We propose allowing compliance with either PSK or QR Code authentication as an acceptable alternative.</p>	<p>We require MIMO or a more advanced technology that provides enhanced performance in the WiFi access point, ensuring higher throughput, improved efficiency, better coverage, and the ability to support multiple concurrent users without degradation in service quality.</p> <p>We require both PSK (Pre-Shared Key) and QR Code-based access for our future security setup to provide flexible and secure WiFi authentication</p>
