

A MINIMAL to MODERATE risk of storm surge may occur in the next 48 hours. However, residents along the coast are advised to take extra precautions due to high waves In the municipalities of:

Residents living in the low-lying coastal communities are still advised to:

- > Stay away from the coast or beach;
- > Cancel all marine activities;
- > Move to higher grounds away from the coast and storm surge-prone areas;
- > Be aware and follow the latest updates from PAGASA

NOTE: Inundation / flood depth due to storm surge depends on the topography of the area.
