

Storm Surge Warning #13

A MODERATE to HIGH risk of storm surge may occur within the next 24-hours. There is a possibility of inundation due to rising sea water along with high waves in the low lying coastal communities in the municipalities of:

Recommended Action

Residents living in the low-lying coastal communities are still advised to:

- > Stay away from the coast or beach;
- > Cancel all marine activities;
- > Move to higher grounds away from the coast and storm surge-prone areas;
- > Be aware and follow the latest updates from PAGASA

NOTE: Inundation / flood depth due to storm surge depends on the topography of the area.
