



WEATHER ADVISORY NO.1

FOR: **LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)**
ISSUED AT: **11:00 AM, 11 OCTOBER 2017**

AT 10:00 AM TODAY, A **LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)** HAS ENTERED THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR) AND WAS ESTIMATED, BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA, AT **940 KM NORTHEAST OF BORONGAN, EASTERN SAMAR** (15.3°N, 133.2°E). CURRENTLY, THIS WEATHER SYSTEM HAS NO EFFECT IN THE COUNTRY. HOWEVER, IT IS **LIKELY TO DEVELOP INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION (TD)** WITHIN THE NEXT 48 HOURS.

MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA PREVIOUSLY LOCATED EAST OF CASIGURAN IS NOW LOCATED AT 250 KM NORTHEAST OF VIRAC, CATANDUANES (15.2°N, 125.8°E). THE WEATHER SYSTEM WILL CONTINUE TO BRING CLOUDY SKIES WITH SCATTERED RAINSHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS PARTICULARLY OVER CAGAYAN VALLEY, THE CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION AND THE PROVINCES OF AURORA AND QUEZON. THE LPA IS EXPECTED TO WEAKEN FURTHER AND THEN DISSIPATE WITHIN THE NEXT 24 HOURS.

THE NEXT UPDATE ON THESE WEATHER DISTURBANCES WILL BE INCOPORATED IN THE 24-HOUR PUBLIC WEATHE FOECAST AT 4:00 PM TODAY AND THE NEXT ADVISORY WILL BE ISSUED AT 11:00 AM TOMORROW.
