FOR: LOW PRESSURE AREA (FORMERLY "AMANG")

TROPICAL CYCLONE: ALERT

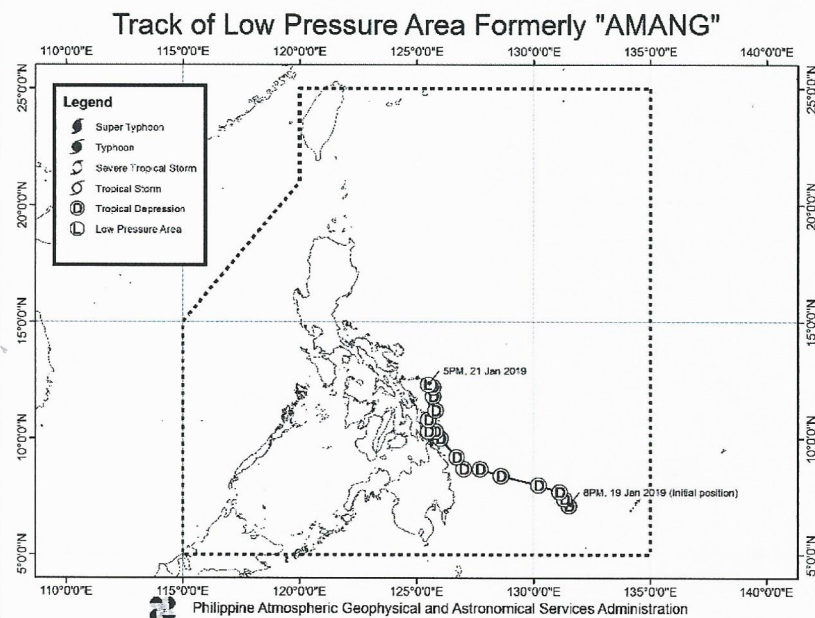
ISSUED AT 8:00 PM, 21 January 2019

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" HAS WEAKENED INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA.

- Tropical Depression "AMANG" has weakened into a Low Pressure Area (LPA) at 5:00 PM today.
- All Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals have been lifted.
- Light to moderate rains are expected over Catanduanes, Camarines Sur, Albay, Sorsogon and Northern Samar within the next 24 hours due to this weather disturbance, along with the tail-end of a cold front. However, these areas may still experience periods of heavy rainfall. Residents of these areas, especially those living in areas at high risk of flooding and landslides, are still advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates, especially the Weather Advisories and the Heavy Rainfall Warnings / Thunderstorm Advisories from PAGASA Regional Services Divisions.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are still advised not to venture out over the seaboards of Northern Luzon and the eastern seaboards of Central Luzon, Southern Luzon, and Visayas due to the surge of Northeast Monsoon.

Location of eye/center

At 7:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area was estimated based on all available data at 85 km East of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.5°N, 125.4°E).



With this development and unless re-intensification occurs, this is the final weather bulletin for this weather disturbance. The next update on this LPA and the tail-end of a cold front will be incorporated in the 4 AM Public Weather Forecast tomorrow and in the weather advisory to be issued at 11 AM tomorrow.
