



## SEVERE WEATHER BULLETIN #6-FINAL

### FOR: TROPICAL STORM "TINO" (KIROGI)

### TROPICAL CYCLONE: ALERT

ISSUED AT 10:00 AM, 18 November 2017

"TINO" HAS INTENSIFIED INTO TROPICAL STORM AND IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Storm.

<b>Location of eye/center</b>	At 9:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "TINO" was estimated based on all available data at 70 km East Northeast of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR)(11.2°N, 114.7°E).	<p><b>Track of Tropical Storm "TINO"</b></p> <p style="font-size: small;">Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration</p>
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum sustained winds of up to 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 90 kph.
