TROPICAL CYCLONE BULLETIN NR. 1

Tropical Depression AURING

Issued at 11:00 PM, 12 June 2025 Valid for broadcast until the next bulletin at 5:00 AM tomorrow.

THE LOW PRESSURE AREA NORTH OF ITBAYAT, BATANES HAS DEVELOPED INTO TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AURING"

Location of Center (10:00 PM)

The center of Tropical Depression AURING was estimated based on all available data at **295 km North of Itbayat, Batanes (23.4°N, 121.5°E).**

Intensity


Maximum sustained winds of **45 km/h** near the center, gustiness of up to **55 km/h**, and central pressure of **1002 hPa**

Present Movement

North northwestward at 15 km/h

Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds

Strong winds extend outwards up to 300 km from the center

Heavy Rainfall Outlook

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HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

24-Hour Sea Condition Outlook

Up to moderate to rough seas over the following coastal waters:

- 2.5 to 3.0 m: The seaboards of Ilocos Region, Zambales, Batanes, and Babuyan Islands.
- Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels.

Up to moderate seas over the following coastal waters:

- Up to 2.5 m: The western seaboards of Bataan and Occidental Mindoro
- Mariners of motorbancas and similarly-sized vessels are advised to take precautionary measures while venturing
 out to sea and, if possible, avoid navigation under these conditions.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

AURING is forecast to continue moving north northwestward and may make landfall over Taiwan between tonight and tomorrow early morning. Due to land interaction, rapid weakening is expected and AURING may be downgraded to a Low Pressure Area tomorrow.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

The next tropical cyclone bulletin will be issued at 5:00 AM tomorrow.
