TROPICAL CYCLONE BULLETIN NR. 28F **Severe Tropical Storm TRAMI (Formerly KRISTINE)**

Issued at 11:00 PM, 25 October 2024

"KRISTINE" MAINTAINS ITS STRENGTH AS IT MOVES WEST SOUTHWESTWARD OVER THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA.

Location of Center (10:00 PM)

The center of Severe Tropical Storm KRISTINE was estimated based on all available data at 535 km West of Bacnotan, La Union (OUTSIDE PAR) (17.4°N, 115.4°E)

Intensity


Maximum sustained winds of 95 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 115 km/h, and central pressure of 985 hPa

Present Movement

West southwestward at 25 km/h

Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds

Strong to storm-force winds extend outwards up to 520 km from the center



OTHER HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Severe Winds

The southwesterly wind flow triggered by both KRISTINE and Tropical Storm KONG-REY outside the PAR region will also bring **strong to gale-force gusts** over the following areas (especially in coastal and upland areas exposed to winds):

- Today (25 October): MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Visayas, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, and Davao Region.
- Tomorrow (26 October): Palawan, Romblon, Western Visayas, Negros Island Region, Siquijor, Bohol, Southern Leyte, Zamboanga del Norte, Camiguin, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Norte.
- Sunday (27 October): Palawan, Romblon, Visayas, Zamboanga del Norte, Camiguin, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Norte.

Coastal Inundation

All Storm Surge Warnings have been lifted.

HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

A Gale Warning is hoisted over the northern and western seaboards of Luzon. For more information, refer to Gale Warning No. 14A issued at 11:00 PM today.

24-Hour Sea Condition Outlook

- Up to very rough over the following coastal waters:
 - o **Up to 4.5 m:** The seaboards of Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Zambales, and Bataan.
 - Sea travel is risky for all types or tonnage of vessels. All mariners must remain in port or, if underway, seek shelter or safe harbor as soon as possible until winds and waves subside.
- Up to rough seas over the following coastal waters:
 - Up to 4.0 m: The seaboards of Batanes, Babuyan Islands, and Ilocos Norte; the western seaboards of Cavite, Batangas, Occidental Mindoro including Lubang Islands and northern Palawan.
 - Up to 3.5 m: The seaboards of mainland Cagayan and Isabela.
 - Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels.
- Up to moderate seas over the following coastal waters:
 - Up to 2.5 m: The remaining seaboards of Luzon and Visayas.
 - Mariners of motorbancas and similarly-sized vessels are advised to take precautionary measures while venturing out to sea and, if possible, avoid navigation under these conditions.

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TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- KRISTINE will continue moving westward over the West Philippine Sea until tomorrow, loop counterclockwise on Sunday and Monday, then move eastward for the remainder of the forecast period. However, this scenario heavily depends on the behavior of tropical cyclone KONG-REY over east of the PAR region and the behavior of other synoptic weather systems surrounding KRISTINE while over the West Philippine Sea.
- This tropical cyclone is forecast to gradually intensify over the West Philippine Sea. While it is likely that the tropical cyclone will remain at severe tropical storm category within the next two days, the chance for it to be upgraded into a typhoon is not ruled out. However, a weakening trend is expected by early next week due to a possible surge of northeasterly wind flow over the West Philippine Sea.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.

With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final tropical cyclone bulletin. Succeeding updates will be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast issued at 4:00 AM and 4:00 PM daily.
