**Tropical Depression JULIAN (KRATHON)**

Issued at 5:00 AM, 04 October 2024

**“JULIAN” FURTHER WEAKENS INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION.**

<b>Location of Center (4:00 AM)</b>	
The center of Tropical Depression JULIAN was estimated based on all available data at <b>240 km North Northwest of Itbayat, Batanes or in the vicinity of Pingtung County, Taiwan (22.6°N, 120.6°E)</b>	
<b>Intensity</b>	
Maximum sustained winds of <b>45 km/h</b> near the center, gustiness of up to <b>75 km/h</b> , and central pressure of <b>1008 hPa</b>	
<b>Present Movement</b>	
<b>Almost stationary</b>	
<b>Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds</b>	
<b>Strong winds</b> extend outwards up to <b>240 km</b> from the center

**HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS**

**24-Hour Sea Condition Outlook**

**Moderate or rough seas** over the following coastal waters:

- **Up to 3.5 m** over the seaboard of Batanes, Babuyan Islands, and Ilocos Norte
- **Up to 3.0 m** over the remaining seaboard of Ilocos Region and the seaboard of Zambales
- **Up to 2.5 m** over the northern seaboard of mainland Cagayan, the seaboard of Bataan, the western seaboard of Lubang Island, the western seaboard of Calamian Islands, the western seaboard of northern mainland Palawan, and the seaboard of Kalayaan Islands

Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels

**TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK**

JULIAN is forecast to weaken into a remnant low today over the landmass of Taiwan or the sea southwest of Taiwan.
