



TROPICAL CYCLONE BULLETIN NR. 3
Severe Tropical Storm GORIO (PODUL)

Issued at 5:00 PM, 11 August 2025

Valid for broadcast until the next bulletin at 11:00 PM today.

“GORIO” SLIGHTLY DECELERATES AS IT MOVES WEST SOUTHWESTWARD OVER THE PHILIPPINE SEA.

Location of Center (4:00 PM)

The center of Severe Tropical Storm GORIO was estimated based on all available data at **1,060 km East of Extreme Northern Luzon (20.5°N, 132.0°E)**.

Intensity

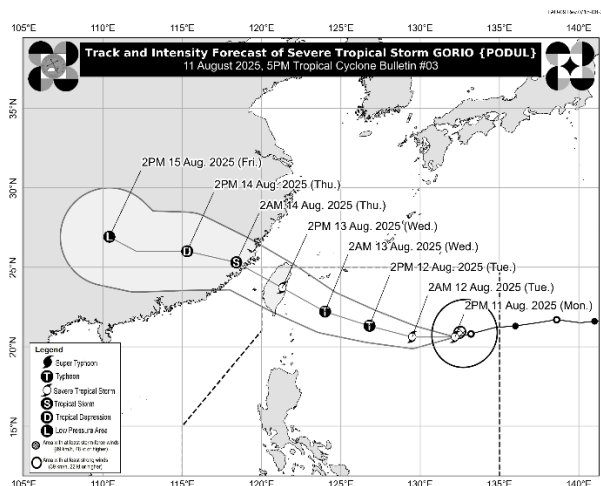
Maximum sustained winds of **110 km/h** near the center, gustiness of up to **135 km/h**, and central pressure of **985 hPa**

Present Movement

West southwestward at 20 km/h

Extent of Tropical Cyclone Winds

Strong to storm-force winds extend outwards up to **300 km** from the center

OTHER HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Severe Winds

GORIO is unlikely to directly affect the country within the next three days. However, in the event of a further southward shift in the forecast track, hoisting of Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 over Extreme Northern Luzon is not ruled out.

HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

GORIO will bring up to moderate seas (up to 2.0 m) over the coastal waters of Extreme Northern Luzon.

Mariners of motor bancas and similarly sized vessels are advised to take precautionary measures while venturing out to sea and, if possible, avoid navigating in these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- GORIO is forecast to move generally westward over the next 12 hours, then turn west northwestward from tomorrow afternoon (12 August) through the end of the forecast period. On the track forecast, GORIO may make landfall over the eastern coast of Taiwan on Wednesday (13 August) afternoon and exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) by Wednesday evening.
- GORIO may reach typhoon category prior to its landfall to Taiwan before weakening throughout the remaining forecast period.

Considering these developments, the public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. Persons living in areas identified to be highly or very highly susceptible to these hazards are advised to follow evacuation and other instructions from local officials. **For heavy rainfall warnings, thunderstorm/rainfall advisories, and other severe weather information specific to your area, please monitor products issued by your local PAGASA Regional Services Division.**
