## For: Strong to Gale-Force winds associated with the Northeast Monsoon

Issued at 08:00 AM Today, 05 January 2025

Valid for broadcast until the next warning at 05:00 PM today

Strong to Gale-Force winds are prevailing or expected to affect the following areas:

THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan Islands, and the northern coast of llocos Norte [Burgos, Bangui, and Pagudpud])	Cloudy skies with rains	(48-63) / (26-34)	rough to very rough	3.1-4.5
THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (The western coast of llocos Norte [Pasuquin, Bacarra, Laoag City, Paoay, Currimao, Pinili, and Badoc], Cagayan, Isabela, Aurora, the northern and eastern coasts of Quezon [General Nakar, Infanta, Real, Mauban, Atimonan, Plaridel, Gumaca, Lopez, Calauag, Quezon, Alabat, and Perez] including Polillo Islands, Camarines Norte, the northern coast of Camarines Sur [Sipocot, Cabusao, Calabanga, Tinambac, Siruma, Lagonoy, Garchitorena, and Caramoan], and the northern and eastern coasts of Catanduanes [Pandan, Bagamanoc, Panganiban, Viga, Gigmoto, Baras, and Bato])	Cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated	(48-68) / (26-36)	rough to very rough	3.1-5.0

Warnings are for sea areas within 30 nautical miles from the coast.

Sea travel is risky for small seacrafts (including all motor bancas of any type or tonnage). Mariners of these vessels are advised to remain in port or seek safe harbor. For larger vessels, operating in these conditions required experience and properly equipped vessels.

Vessel masters, boat captains, ship owners / operators, and Coast Guard units concerned are advised to take appropriate measures to ensure safety of life at sea. Unless there is an intermediate issuance, the next warning will be issued at 05:00 PM today
