For: Strong to Gale-Force winds associated with NORTHEAST MONSOON

Issued at 05:00 PM Today, 24 January 2024

Valid for broadcast until the next warning at 05:00 AM tomorrow.

Strong to Gale-Force winds are prevailing or expected to affect the following areas:

THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL LUZON (The northern coast of Ilocos Norte, Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with rains	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	rough to very rough	2.8 - 5.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Northern Quezon[General Nakar] including the northern and eastern coasts of Polillo Islands [the northern coast of Panukulan, Burdeos, the eastern coast of Patnanungan, and Jomalig], the northern coast of Camarines Norte [Calaguas Islands], and the northern and eastern coasts of Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (The western coast of Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union[Bangar, Luna, Balaoan, Bacnotan, San Juan, San Fernando City, and Bauang], and Pangasinan [Bolinao, Anda, Bani, Agno, Burgos, and Dasol])	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF VISAYAS (Northern Samar [Laoang, Palapag, Mapanas, Gamay, Lapinig, San Roque, Pambujan, and Mondragon])	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5

Warnings are for sea areas within 30 nautical miles from the coast.
