Warnings are for sea areas within 30 nautical miles from the coast.

In rough to high, very high, or phenomenal seas, sea travel is risky for vessels of any type or tonnage. All mariners must remain in port or, if underway, seek shelter or safe harbor as soon as possible until winds and waves subside.

In other areas, sea travel is risky for small seacrafts (including all motor bancas of any type or tonnage).Mariners of these vessels are advised to remain in port or seek safe harbor. For larger vessels, operating in these conditions required experience and properly equipped vessels.

Vessel masters, boat captains, ship owners / operators, and Coast Guard units concerned are advised to take appropriate measures to ensure safety of life at sea. Unless there is an intermediate issuance, the next warning will be issued at 05:00 AM tomorrow
