## WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK

July 12 - 19, 2024

**Today until Tomorrow (July 12-13)**, MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, and Mindanao may experience cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms due to the Southwest Monsoon or "Habagat". Meanwhile, the rest of the country will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, mostly in the afternoon or evening.

**From Sunday until Monday (July 14-15)**, The Southwest Monsoon will continue to bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Palawan, Western Visayas, Central Visayas, Northern Mindanao, and Zamboanga Peninsula. Metro Manila and the rest of the archipelago will be partly cloudy to cloudy apart from isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms in the afternoon or evening.

**By Tuesday until Wednesday (July 16-17)**, Palawan, Mindoro Provinces, Cavite, Laguna, Western Visayas, and Zamboanga Peninsula are expected to have cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms due to Habagat. Meanwhile, possible formation of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) will bring mostly cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms over Caraga, Davao region, and Northern Mindanao. The rest of the country will experience partly cloudy to cloudy skies with chances of isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

**By Thursday until Friday (July 18-19)**, The Low Pressure Area (LPA) and the Southwest Monsoon will cause cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms over Palawan, Visayas and Bicol region. The rest of the archipelago will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with possibilities of isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

The updates on this outlook will be provided through the daily issuances of Public Weather Forecasts and Weather Advisories if there are significant changes in the weather scenario.
