WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK

18 - 25 JUNE 2021

TODAY UNTIL WEDNESDAY (**18 - 23 JUNE**), THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON WILL CONTINUE TO AFFECT THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. METRO MANILA, CALABARZON AND MIMAROPA WILL EXPECT A FAIR WEATHER CONDITION IN THE MORNING BECOMING CLOUDY SKIES WITH SCATTERED RAINSHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS IN THE AFTERNOON. WHILE, VISAYAS, MINDANAO AND THE REST OF LUZON WILL HAVE PARTLY CLOUDY TO CLOUDY SKIES WITH ISOLATED RAINSHOWERS OR THUNDERSTORMS.

BY THURSDAY UNTIL FRIDAY (**24 - 25 JUNE**), THE EFFECT OF SOUTHWEST MONSOON WILL WEAKEN BRINGING GENERALLY FAIR WEATHER CONDITION ASIDE FROM ISOLATED RAINSHOWERS OR THUNDERSTORMS MOSTLY IN THE AFTERNOON OR EVENING OVER METRO MANILA AND THE REST OF THE COUNTRY.

THROUGHOUT OF THE OUTLOOK PERIOD (**18 - 25 JUNE**), SLIM CHANCE OF TROPICAL CYCLONE DEVELOPMENT IS EXPECTED. HOWEVER, THIS OUTLOOK WILL BE UPDATED IF SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE WEATHER PATTERN OCCURS.
