



TROPICAL CYCLONE ADVISORY # 2

FOR: Tropical Depression

Issued at 11:00 AM, 11 September 2019

Valid broadcast until the next advisory to be issued at 11 AM Tomorrow

The Tropical Depression outside PAR has slightly intensified and is now moving in a east-northeastward direction.

Location of Center (10:00 AM today)	The center of Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at 1,495 km East of Visayas (OUTSIDE PAR) (13.1°N, 139.3°E)	
Maximum Sustained Winds	55 km/h near the center.	
Gustiness	Up to 70 km/h	
Movement	East Northeast at 15 km/h	

Forecast Positions and Intensities

Tomorrow morning 12 September 2019	1,390 km East of Daet, Camarines Norte (OUTSIDE PAR) (15.6°N, 135.8°E) Tropical Storm
Friday morning 13 September 2019	1,150 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (17.8°N, 132.5°E) Tropical Storm
Saturday morning 14 September 2019	965 km East of Basco, Batanes (21.2°N, 131.2°E) Tropical Storm
Sunday morning 15 September 2019	1,225 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.6°N, 133.0°E) Severe Tropical Storm
Monday morning 16 September 2019	1,460 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (26.8°N, 134.5°E) Severe Tropical Storm

- The Tropical Depression is forecast to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility within 48 hrs and will be named "MARILYN".
- The trough of the Tropical Depression and the Southwest Monsoon will bring scattered light to moderate rains with at times heavy rains (during thunderstorms) over Mindoro Provinces, Romblon, Marinduque, northern portion of Palawan (including Calamian and Cuyo Island), Visayas and Bicol Region.
- This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall in the country.

The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4 PM today and 4 AM tomorrow. The next advisory will be issued at 11 AM tomorrow.
