Issued at 11:00 AM, 21 July 2018

SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "AMPIL" HAS MADE LANDFALL OVER OKINAWA ISLAND, JAPAN AND IS NOW HEADING TOWARDS EASTERN CHINA.
