## WEATHER ADVISORY NO. 4

FOR: LPA  
ISSUED AT: 11:00 PM, 03 DECEMBER 2021

AT 10:00 PM TODAY, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 935 KM EAST OF MINDANAO (10.2°N, 134.0°E). THIS WEATHER DISTURBANCE IS LESS LIKELY TO DEVELOP INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION WITHIN THE NEXT 48 HOURS.

### HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND

IN THE NEXT 24 HOURS, **MODERATE TO HEAVY WITH AT TIMES INTENSE RAINS** ARE LIKELY OVER CARAGA, DAVAO REGION, SOCCSKSARGEN, AND BARMM. LIGHT TO MODERATE WITH **AT TIMES HEAVY RAINS** OVER NORTHERN MINDANAO AND ZAMBOANGA PENINSULA. UNDER THESE CONDITIONS, OCCURRENCE OF SCATTERED FLASH FLOODS AND RAIN-INDUCED LANDSLIDES ARE POSSIBLE, ESPECIALLY IN AREAS THAT ARE HIGHLY OR VERY HIGHLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO THESE HAZARDS AS IDENTIFIED IN HAZARD MAPS.

CONSIDERING THESE DEVELOPMENTS, THE PUBLIC AND DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICES CONCERNED ARE ADVISED TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY MEASURES TO PROTECT LIFE AND PROPERTY. PERSONS LIVING IN AREAS IDENTIFIED TO BE HIGHLY OR VERY HIGHLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO THESE HAZARDS ARE ADVISED TO FOLLOW EVACUATION AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FROM LOCAL OFFICIALS. **FOR HEAVY RAINFALL WARNINGS, THUNDERSTORM/RAINFALL ADVISORIES, AND OTHER SEVERE WEATHER INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO YOUR AREA, PLEASE MONITOR PRODUCTS ISSUED BY YOUR LOCAL PAGASA REGIONAL SERVICES DIVISION.**

UNLESS SUPERSEDED BY AN INTERMEDIATE ISSUANCE, THE NEXT WEATHER ADVISORY WILL BE ISSUED AT 11:00 AM TOMORROW.
