<b>Heavy to Intense (100 – 200 mm)</b>	<b>Camarines Norte, Isabela, Mountain Province, Kalinga, Abra, Nueva Ecija, La Union, Bulacan, and Rizal</b>	-	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Numerous flooding events are likely, especially in areas that are urbanized, low lying, or near rivers.</li> <li>Landslide likely in moderate to highly susceptible areas.</li> </ul>
<b>Moderate to Heavy (50 – 100 mm)</b>	<b>Catanduanes, Camarines Sur, Metro Manila, Bataan, Zambales, Tarlac, Pampanga, and Laguna</b>	-	-	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Localized flooding is possible mainly in areas that are urbanized, low lying, or near rivers.</li> <li>Landslide possible in highly susceptible areas.</li> </ul>

Forecast rainfall may be higher in mountainous and elevated areas. Moreover, impacts in some areas maybe worsened by significant antecedent rainfall.

The public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measures to protect life and property. PAGASA Regional Services Divisions may issue Heavy Rainfall Warnings, Rainfall/Thunderstorms Advisories, and other severe weather information specific to their areas of responsibility as appropriate.

Unless significant changes occur, the next Weather Advisory will be issued at 2:00 PM today.
