## HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

TODAY (MAY 30), THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON WILL BRING MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS (50-100MM) OVER ILOCOS REGION, AND ZAMBALES.

UNDER THESE CONDITIONS, FLOODING AND RAIN-INDUCED LANDSLIDES ARE LIKELY, ESPECIALLY IN AREAS THAT ARE HIGHLY OR VERY HIGHLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO THESE HAZARDS AS IDENTIFIED IN HAZARD MAPS AND IN AREAS WITH SIGNIFICANT ANTECEDENT RAINFALL.

THE PUBLIC AND DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICES CONCERNED ARE ADVISED TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY MEASURES TO PROTECT LIFE AND PROPERTY. PAGASA REGIONAL SERVICES DIVISIONS MAY ISSUE LOCAL HEAVY RAINFALL WARNINGS, RAINFALL/THUNDERSTORM ADVISORIES, AND OTHER SEVERE WEATHER INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO THEIR AREAS OF RESPONSIBILTY AS APPROPRIATE.

UNLESS SIGNIFICANT CHANGES OCCUR, THE NEXT WEATHER ADVISORY WILL BE ISSUED AT 11:00 PM TODAY.
